Apr 2023 – May 2024

- Built the front end for a ground-up rebuild of a licensing and audit service for a government ministry, in Vue and ASP.NET, from requirements and design review through to production delivery.
- Joined a newly formed AI team for the final five months and built the document ingestion pipeline behind a retrieval-augmented assistant used by ministry staff, including work to reduce hallucinated answers.
- The assistant shipped as a product rather than a prototype; the team carried it forward after the internship ended.
- Extended past the original internship contract to continue the work.

SELECTED PROJECTS

AnimeKaiser

2026

Self-hosted anime library with two-way synchronisation across AniList and MyAnimeList. Bun, Effect, TanStack Start, Drizzle, PostgreSQL.

- Outbound changes become durable, retryable jobs dispatched over Postgres LISTEN/NOTIFY rather than an external queue.
- Source resolution sits behind a typed RPC boundary in a separate service, so the published repository depends on an interface, not an implementation.
- Six-package Effect monorepo with passkey authentication and end-to-end tests running in CI on every deploy.

2024

Data patch and query management system. Next.js, Prisma, AWS Lambda, GitHub Actions.

- Replaced an ad-hoc manual database-change process with a reviewed, audited workflow: request submission, approval routing, execution logging and a searchable audit trail.
- Proposed and prototyped independently, then led a small team of interns through delivery.

ClickToEat

2022 – 2023

Restaurant review platform built across four polytechnic modules. Kotlin, Jetpack Compose, Hilt, Google Maps SDK, Firebase Cloud Messaging.

- Each module required a different platform, so the same product was carried through a web app, a TypeScript REST API, a native Android client and a Flutter client, making the stacks directly comparable.
- The Android client is a multi-module build following Clean Architecture, with 43 unit and instrumented UI test files (JUnit, Mockito, Compose Test, UI Automator).

Command line tools

2026

Go, Cobra, Bubble Tea.

- *ntmux* applies tmux sessions from JSON or YAML; *zap* finds and clears build artefacts; *cmdhelper* turns natural language into shell commands using local shell and git context.
